HDOT is declaring this portion of the HBR in the vicinity of Wailuku Bridge to be a traffic emergency zone in accordance with HRS 264-1.5, which provides the Governor or the State Director of Transportation with emergency powers to establish traffic emergency zones to provide access to designated areas to protect public health and safety in cases of highway closures. The proposed maintenance and repair work at the bridge will consist of removing the rust and scale, patching existing structure with new steel plates, and painting with a coating. The project will maintain this existing bridge in serviceable condition with its same scope, scale, and size, while extending its service life and allowing its continued use. All work and construction staging will occur within the existing roadway (ROW) and be above the mean high tide line.
