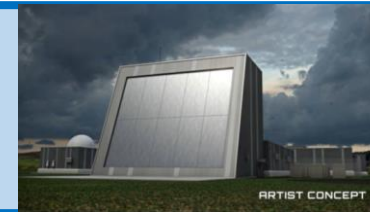


# Missile Defense Agency Homeland Defense Radar–Hawaii Environmental Impact Statement Public Outreach and Scoping



**The Missile Defense Agency (MDA)** is reopening the public scoping period for the Homeland Defense Radar–Hawaii (HDR-H) Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), due to changes in the proposed alternatives. In 2018, the HDR-H alternatives included Kuaokalā Ridge (KR) adjacent to the U.S. Air Force Ka‘ena Point Satellite Tracking Station on state-owned land, and two alternative sites at U.S. Army Kahuku Training Area (KTA). In 2020, the MDA removed the KR and KTA Site 2 alternatives from further consideration for HDR-H, and added a new alternative at the U.S. Navy Pacific Missile Range Facility (PMRF) on the island of Kaua‘i.

The EIS analysis will include three alternatives: one on O‘ahu (KTA-1), one on Kaua‘i (PMRF), and a No Action Alternative. Should a deployment decision be made and is funded and if the HDR-H is constructed on O‘ahu, the U.S. Air Force Solar Observatory on O‘ahu would be relocated to either the Air Force Research Laboratory Remote Maui Experiment site on Maui or to PMRF on Kaua‘i. This public scoping effort will also supplement additional consultation under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 and its implementing regulations at 36 Code of Federal Regulations Part 800.

**Proposed Action:** Construct, test, and operate the HDR-H in Hawaii, including associated support facilities and infrastructure. Connected actions include the establishment of restricted airspace for the HDR-H site and the potential relocation of facilities.

**Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the MDA is providing an Online Open House website and will hold Telephone Public Meetings in place of in-person public scoping meetings.
