### NEGATIVE DECLARATIONS

The applicant is requesting a community plan amendment to increase project No. 9 to include the property and expand the range of permitted uses. Proposed are two 18-hole golf courses, a mixed use village center and a resort lodge in addition to the original single family and multi-family dwelling units. The subject 370 acres (TMK:2-1-8-56 and 71) is part of a 670-acre parcel. The 670-acre parcel is rectangular in configuration and is bounded by pasture lands to the east, Maui Meadows rural residential subdivision to the north, the ailea resort to the west, and undeveloped lands owned by Seibu Hawaii

The following are Negative Declarations or determinations made by proposing or approving agencies that certain proposed actions will not have significant effects on the environment and therefore do not require EISs (EIS Rules 11-200-11). Publication in the Bulletin of a Negative Declaration initiates a 60-day period during which litigation measures may be instituted. Copies are available at 25 cents per page upon request to the Office.
