'An Introduction to the Commission on Water Resource Management: Selected Policies and Programs and Connections to the ORMP'

Neal Fujii is the State Drought and Water Conservation Coordinator for the Commission on Water Resource Management (CWRM)'s Planning Branch. He attended the University of Hawaii at Mānoa earning a B.S. degree in Meteorology. Mr. Fujii coordinates the State's Water Conservation and Drought Programs. Current projects include implementation of the Water Resources Protection Plan, and the State Water Audit Program.

This month we are examining the impacts of surface and groundwater management on coastal and marine ecosystems. The ORMP strives for a holistic approach to coastal zone management and stewardship. Therefore, it is important to consider the roles of various stakeholders and involved agencies in resource management and permitting. With this understanding, we hope to build partnerships that strengthen a mauka to makai approach and move towards cross-departmental engagement.

Our March presenter will focus on the programs and responsibilities of the Commission on Water Resource Management and how we might find future opportunities for collaboration in implementing the ORMP.
