Source: All station information was gathered by DOH EMSIPSB staff members and first responder agencies throughout 2025.

Purpose: This map serves as a visualization of all Fire and Volunteer Fire Stations across the state for stakeholders and the public.

Note: The points indicating the stations on each island may be color coded to increase visibility and readability. For example: Kaua’i: purple, O’ahu: yellow, Moloka’i: green, Lāna’i: orange, Maui: pink, Hawai’i Island: red.
