

About the NEPM Program

- Preserve unique ecosystem types and geological features
- Predominately work in the Natural Area Reserves Systems
- Mission also encompasses working in ecosystems with high conservation value
 - Presence of rare and endangered species
 - Unique ecosystems
 - Native habitat/ communities



Angiopteris evecta (AngEve)

- Species of concern for high priority conservation areas
- Massive staff and collaborative effort in Kaluanui NAR and Poamoho
- Populations on Oahu's state managed land have not been mapped.
- Minimal management across priority areas because lack of staff or lower priority on task list



AngEve Specialized Volunteer Project

- Train volunteers to do specialized resource management work
- Allow them to track and record data for our program
 - Herbicide used or treated plants
 - Population information
 - Mature vs Immature
 - GIS Point location









Goals for Project


- Keep all relevant information in the same place

- Engage in landscape level efforts








Why the Hub?


