TO: All Executive Department and Agency Heads

FROM: Michael P. Victorino, Mayor 

SUBJECT: Expedited Permitting for Closed and Partially Closed Businesses

This directive calls for all permitting departments and agencies to expedite permits for certain repairs and renovations during the COVID-19 crisis for businesses that are fully or partially closed pursuant to the Governor's and my emergency proclamations.
