The Selected Professional Services Consultant shall be part of a Project Management Team providing professional services and support to the State of Hawaii and Department of Public Safety, from project solicitation to project completion of a New turnkey OCCC Facility and provide professional support in executing innovative project delivery initiatives not withstanding methodologies such as leveraging multiple projects if deemed beneficial for the State of Hawaii.

#### TOD/Smart Growth Need/s to be Addressed

Improvements to the public transportation corridors servicing the Halawa Valley Industrial Area and Hallawa Valley commercial district will need to be upgraded to address the increase in commercial, industrial and public useage of the area. This woulld included, but not limited to, improvements to existing utilities (electrical, sewer, water, gas, etc.) and improved public and pedestrian access to and from the area.

## Community Benefits/Impacts if Funded

Community benefits includes improved transportation and infrastructure improvements promoting future growth and commerce in the area.

### Impact on Project if Funding Deferred

If funding deferred, PSD will continue to operate its existing OCCC Facility, currently located at the end of Kamehameha Highway-Dillingham Blvd, where its current design life have now far exceed its capacity and would require significant improvements and upgrades to meet current security and operational demands mandated by the State of Hawaii.


#### Addtional Information






Figure 17: AQS Visual Analysis
