Neighbor Island TOD Council members have expressed concern that TOD on Neighbor Island counties is not getting the support needed to advance their TOD and Smart Growth strategies.

Community Benefits/Impacts if Funded Implementation of keystone projects could provide needed affordable housing in more compact, complete communities, increasing walkability and multi-modal transportation options, reducing reliance on automobiles, and conserving open space and rural lands.

Impact on Project if Funding Deferred

Implementation of keystone projects will be delayed or put on hold, as will opportunities to advance planning for affordable housing in TOD communities.
