

- CONTINUED CLAIMS People receiving unemployment benefits.

INITIAL CLAIMS


May include people that do not qualify for unemployment benefits:

- self-employed
- transient workers people who have not worked in Hawaii for the past 12 months (may be able to claim in another state)
- people that were not working or can't provide documentation that they worked



CONTINUED CLAIMS AKA WEEKS CLAIMED


Maui County residents affected by the fires are not required to register or search for work. (Must stay in Maui County. If you move, for example, to Hilo, then you must register and search for work.)


Maui Island Unemployment Claims – Weeks Claimed

Weeks Claimed as a % of State Total








PARTIAL UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS

• If you are still attached to your regular employer, worked less than your full-time hours, and earned less than your weekly benefit amount during a week, you may be eligible for partial unemployment benefits.

• People receiving PARTIAL UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS are counted as EMPLOYED and NOT UNEMPLOYED.





Statewide Average Daily Domestic Passenger Count



Maui Average Daily Domestic Passenger Count




Domestic Transpacific Daily Passenger Counts to Maui





Domestic Daily Transpacific Passenger Counts by Island







Kahului Airport Scheduled Air Service



Number of Scheduled Flights




Number of Scheduled Air Seats

State of Hawai'i Monthly Hotel Performance



Maui County Monthly Hotel Performance





County of Maui Hotel Performance by Week for Participating Properties






Wailea and West Maui Daily Hotel Performance





Air Ticket Bookings to Maui – All Markets






