## **ORDER**

I.

By transmittal filed on June 17, 2002, AKINA BUS SERVICE, LTD. (Akina Bus Service) seeks commission approval on short notice of certain changes to its tariff. Akina Bus Service makes its request in accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes § 271-21 and Hawaii Administrative Rules § 6-63-18. The proposed effective date of the transmittal is June 22, 2002.

For the island of Maui, Akina Bus Service possesses regular route authority in the over-25 passenger classification. It seeks to offer and provide the following regular route shuttle services:

- 1. The Central Maui Connection Shuttle, operating from Kahale Ake Ola to Maalaea Harbor Village, with scheduled stops in between.
- 2. The West and South Maui Shuttle, operating from Uwapo and South Kihei Road to Kilohana Drive and South Kihei Road, with scheduled stops in between.

Akina Bus Service seeks "to perform the shuttle service[s] as soon as possible, and not leave the consumers without a regular route transportation service." Specifically,

Akina Bus Service explains that it was recently awarded a contract to provide transportation services along the route of the West and South Maui Shuttle, to commence on July 1, 2002, or earlier.

Akina Bus Service also proposes to modify certain pickup times for the Wailea Resort Shuttle and the South Maui Shopping Shuttle, two existing regular route services.

Upon review, the commission finds good cause to grant the request for approval on short notice.

II.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that Akina Bus Service Ltd.'s transmittal, filed on June 17, 2002, is approved on short notice, to be effective from June 22, 2002.
