ORDER

By Decision and Order No. 18656, filed on June 28, 2001, application of VOYTEK approved the JARNOT. dba we HAWAII PARADISE TRAVEL (Applicant), for a certificate to operate as a common carrier of property by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 8-to-25 passenger classification. We also: (1) ordered Applicant, as a condition to our approval of the application, to comply with all commission requirements for common carriers, including submitting certain documents within the issuance of 120 days of the decision and order; and (2) notified Applicant that failure to timely comply with the commission's requirements would constitute cause for the commission to void the decision and order. We served Applicant with a copy of the decision and order by mail, postage prepaid, on the same day that the decision and order was issued, in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules §§ 6-61-21 and 6-61-122. Additionally, we sent a letter to Applicant, dated June 28, 2001, which reiterated the commission's requirements and specified October 28, 2001, as the deadline for compliance. On November 9, 2001,

Applicant filed a request for a 30-day extension to comply. The commission approved the request on November 13, 2001.

The extended due date has passed, and Applicant has not complied with the requirements set forth under Decision and Order No. 18656. The commission, thus, determines that Decision and Order No. 18656 should be voided.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that Decision and Order No. 18656 is voided and this docket is closed.
