<u>ORDER</u>

By Decision and Order No. 18630, filed on June 25, 2001, approved the application of PHILLIP J. HALL, SR., we dba P.H. EQUIPMENT RENTAL (Applicant), for a certificate to operate as a common carrier of property by motor vehicle over irregular routes island of Oahu in the dump truck classification. on the We also: (1) ordered Applicant, as a condition to our approval of the application, to comply with all commission requirements for common carriers, including submitting certain documents within 120 days of the issuance of the decision and order; and (2) notified Applicant that failure to timely comply with the commission's requirements would constitute cause for the commission to void the decision and order. We served Applicant with a copy of the decision and order by mail, postage prepaid, on the same day that the decision and order was issued, in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules §§ 6-61-21 and 6-61-122. Additionally, we sent a letter to Applicant, dated June 25, 2001, which reiterated the commission's requirements and specified October 25, 2001, as the deadline for compliance.

On October 16, 2001, Applicant filed a request for a 30-day extension to comply. The request was approved on October 18, 2001. On November 20, 2001, Applicant filed a request for an additional 60-day extension to comply. The request was approved on November 21, 2001.

The extended due date has passed, and Applicant has not complied with the requirements set forth under Decision and Order No. 18630. The commission, thus, determines that Decision and Order No. 18630 should be voided.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that Decision and Order No. 18630 is voided and this docket is closed.
