ORDER

By Decision and Order No. 18611, filed on June 22, 2001, JIM the application of R. SIMPSON, dba we approved JRS TRANSPORTATION (Applicant), for a certificate to operate as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 1-to-7 and 8-to-25 passenger classifications. We also: (1) ordered Applicant, as a condition to our approval of the application, to comply with all commission requirements for common carriers, including submitting certain documents within 120 days of the issuance of the decision and order; and (2) notified Applicant that failure to timely comply with the commission's requirements would constitute cause for the commission to void the decision and order. We served Applicant with a copy of the decision and order by mail, postage prepaid, on the same day that the decision and order was issued, in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules 6-61-21 and 6-61-122. §§ Additionally, we sent a letter to Applicant, dated June 22, 2001, which reiterated the commission's requirements and specified October 22, 2001, as the deadline for compliance.

On October 30, 2001, Applicant filed a request for a 60-day extension to comply, until December 22, 2001. The request was approved on November 14, 2001. On December 26, 2001, Applicant filed a request for an additional 60-day extension to comply, until February 22, 2002. The request was approved on December 27, 2001.

The extended due date has passed, and Applicant has not complied with the requirements set forth under Decision and Order No. 18611. The commission, thus, determines that Decision and Order No. 18611 should be voided.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that Decision and Order No. 18611 is voided and this docket is closed.
