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ORDER

I.

By an application filed on November 6, 2001, HAWAIIAN ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC. (HECO) requests commission approval to commit an estimated \$26.9 million for Item P0000064, relating to its Waiau fuel pipeline project. HECO makes its request in accordance with Section 2.3.g.2 of General Order No. 7, <u>Standards</u> for Electricity Utility Service in the State of Hawaii.

Copies of the application were served on the Division of Consumer Advocacy, Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs (Consumer Advocate). By Order No. 19185, filed on February 4, 2002, the commission granted HECO's request to extend the applicable General Order No. 7, Section 2.3.g.2, deadline, from February 4, 2002 to May 6, 2002. By Order No. 19340, filed on May 8, 2002, the commission granted HECO's request to extend the applicable General Order No. 7, Section 2.3.g.2 deadline, from May 6, 2002 to July 5, 2002. By Order No. 19527 filed on August 20, 2002, the commission granted HECO's request to extend the applicable General Order No. 7, Section 2.3.g.2 deadline, from from May 6, 2002 to August 15, 2002 and from August 15, 2002 to September 30, 2002. By Order No. 19684, filed on September 30, 2002, the commission extended the applicable General Order No. 7, Section 2.3.g.2 deadline, from September 30, 2002 to October 7, 2002.

By letter dated October 4, 2002, HECO requests an extension of time, until October 31, 2002, of Section 2.3.g.2's requirement that the commission render a decision within 90 days after the filing of an electric utility's application. HECO makes its request in order to provide additional time for the Consumer Advocate to complete its investigation and to issue a statement of position.

Upon review, the commission finds good cause to grant HECO's request to extend the applicable Section 2.3.g.2 deadline.

II.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that HECO's request to extend the applicable General Order No. 7, Section 2.3.g.2, deadline from October 7, 2002 to October 31, 2002, is granted.
