ORDER

By Decision and Order No. 19253, filed on March 18, 2002, we approved the application of HAI THANH TRAN (Applicant) for a certificate to operate as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu 8-to-25 passenger classification, limited to limousines. (1) ordered Applicant, as a condition to our approval of the application, to comply with all commission requirements for common carriers, including submitting certain documents within 120 days of the issuance of the decision and order; and (2) notified Applicant that failure to timely comply with the commission's requirements would constitute cause for the commission to void the decision and order. We served Applicant with a copy of the decision and order by mail, postage prepaid, on the same day that the decision and order was issued, in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules Additionally, we sent a letter to §§ 6-61-21 and 6-61-122. Applicant, dated March 18, 2002, which reiterated the commission's requirements and specified July 18, 2002, as the deadline for compliance.

On July 8, 2002, Applicant filed a request for an extension until October 14, 2002 to comply. The request was approved on July 9, 2002. On September 27, 2002, Applicant filed a request for an additional 9-month extension to comply. This request was denied on September 30, 2002.

The approved extended due date of October 14, 2002 has passed, and Applicant has not complied with the requirements set forth under Decision and Order No. 19253. The commission, thus, determines that Decision and Order No. 19253 should be voided.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that Decision and Order No. 19253 is voided and this docket is closed.
