ORDER

I.

By letter filed on April 26, 2002, TRI-CITY TRAVEL, INC. (Petitioner) requested that certificate of public convenience and necessity no. 4841-C (Certificate No. 4841-C) be placed on inactive status. Certificate No. 4841-C authorizes Petitioner to transport passengers over irregular routes on the island of Maui in the 8-to-25 passenger classification, excluding travel on Hawaii State Route 31, south of Tedeschi Vineyards in Ulupalakua to Hana; Hawaii State Route 360 (Hana Highway), east of Hookipa Park on Hawaii State Route 36; north of the Kapalua Plantation Course on Hawaii State Route 30; and north of Waiehu Golf Course on Hawaii State Route 340.

On December 17, 2002, in Docket No. 02-0301, the commission issued Decision and Order No. 19892, which revoked Certificate No. 4841-C for Petitioner's failure to pay an assessed penalty of \$250.33 for Petitioner's untimely filing of its 2001 annual financial report.

The revocation of Petitioner's operating authority renders moot Petitioner's request to place Certificate No. 4841-C on inactive status. Thus, we conclude that there is good cause to dismiss the petition in this docket.

II.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that the petition filed on April 26, 2002, is dismissed and this docket is closed.
