THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Petitioner's Certificate No. 1609-C is placed on inactive status for an additional one-year period, until February 6, 2004.


2. If Certificate No. 1609-C is not reactivated prior to the expiration of the period of inactivity, it shall be declared abandoned and revoked. Petitioner may reactivate the certificate at any time prior to the expiration of the inactive period by filing a request to reactivate with the commission, and fulfilling the requirements for motor carriers including, but not limited to, filing of appropriate insurance documents and publication of a lawful tariff.

3. Petitioner shall not transfer his inactive certificate unless Petitioner can first establish good cause to the commission for the transfer, and the commission has approved the request to transfer.


