ORDER


By Decision and Order No. 19791, filed on November 20, 2002, we approved the application of T-N-T EQUIPMENT RENTAL INC. (Applicant) to extend its authority under certificate of public convenience and necessity number 2119-C to include the general commodities classification. We also: (1) ordered Applicant, as a condition to our approval of the application, to comply with all commission requirements for common carriers, including submitting certain documents within 120 days of the issuance of the decision and order; and (2) notified Applicant that failure to timely comply with the commission's requirements would constitute cause for the commission to void the decision and order. We served Applicant with a copy of the decision and order by mail, postage prepaid, on the same day that the decision and order was issued, in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules §§ 6-61-21 and 6-61-122. Additionally, we sent a letter to Applicant, dated November 20, 2002, which reiterated the commission's requirements and specified March 20, 2003, as the deadline for compliance.


The 120-day time period has passed, and Applicant has not complied with the requirements set forth under Decision and Order No. 19791. The commission, thus, determines that Decision and Order No. 19791 should be voided.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that Decision and Order No. 19791 is voided and this docket is closed.


