ORDER

I.

By Order No. 18484, filed on April 12, 2001, in this docket, certificate of public convenience and necessity no. 983-C (Certificate No. 983-C), held by METRO PACIFIC, INC. (Petitioner), was placed on inactive status until April 12, 2002. By Order No. 19329, filed on May 3, 2002, Certificate No. 983-C was placed on inactive status for an additional year, until April 12, 2003. The commission notes that under Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) § 271-19, the commission may grant inactive status for a cumulative period not to exceed two years over the life of the certificate.

By letter filed on April 22, 2003, Petitioner requests commission approval to voluntarily surrender its authority under Certificate No. 983-C. Under Certificate No. 983-C, Petitioner is authorized to transport passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 1-to-7 passenger classification.

In accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) § 271-19, operating authority under a certificate of public

convenience and necessity may be terminated upon application of the holder. The commission finds good cause to grant Petitioner's request to terminate its authority.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 1. Petitioner's authority to transport passengers under Certificate No. 983-C is terminated, effective from the date of this order.
- 2. Petitioner shall surrender its certificate and remove any markings from the vehicles used in its operations. Petitioner shall comply with the foregoing requirements within 30 days from the date of this order.
- 3. If Petitioner fails to comply with the foregoing requirements within the time period specified, it may be subject to penalties pursuant to HRS § 271-27.
 - 4. This docket is closed.
