ORDER

I.

By letter received by the commission on May 19, 2003, APOLLO AGENCY OF AMERICA, INC. (Petitioner) requests that the inactive status of its certificate of public convenience and necessity no. 1010-C (Certificate No. 1010-C) be extended for an additional year. By Order No. 19368, filed on May 28, 2002, in this docket, Certificate No. 1010-C was placed on inactive status until May 28, 2003.

The commission notes that under Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) § 271-19, the commission may grant inactive status for a cumulative period not to exceed two years over the life of the certificate. We find that there is good cause to grant Petitioner's request for an extension of its inactive status for an additional year. We conclude that Petitioner's request should be granted.

II.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


1. Petitioner's Certificate No. 1010-C is placed on inactive status for an additional one-year period, until May 28, 2004.


2. If Certificate No. 1010-C is not reactivated prior to the expiration of the period of inactivity, it shall be declared abandoned and revoked. Petitioner may reactivate the certificate at any time prior to the expiration of the inactive period by filing a request to reactivate with the commission, and fulfilling the requirements for motor carriers including, but not limited to, filing of appropriate insurance documents and publication of a lawful tariff.

3. Petitioner shall not transfer its inactive certificate unless Petitioner can first establish good cause to the commission for the transfer, and the commission has approved the request to transfer.




