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ORDER

I.

By Decision and Order No. 19398, filed on June 3, 2002, the commission approved a license between HAWAIIAN ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC. ("HECO") and the Hawaii Natural Energy Institute of the University of Hawaii at Manoa ("HNEI"), dated December 4, 2001 ("License").<sup>1</sup> Decision and Order No. 19398 required, among other things, HECO to submit a status report on the Fuel Cell Facility within 60 days of the operational start-up of the Fuel Cell Facility. The Fuel Cell Facility was operational on April 24, 2003, and accordingly, the status report was due to be filed on June 24, 2003.

By letter dated June 24, 2003, HECO requests a 2-week extension of time, until July 8, 2003, for HECO to file its

initial status report on the Fuel Cell Facility. HECO represents that the Division of Consumer Advocacy, Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs ("Consumer Advocate") does not object to this request for an extension of time. HECO's request appears to be reasonable and accordingly, the commission concludes that Decision and Order No. 19398 should be amended to defer the filing of HECO initial status report until July 8, 2003.

II.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


1. HECO's request to defer filing its initial status report until July 8, 2003 is approved.

2. Decision and Order No. 19398 is amended consistent with the terms and conditions of this order. In all other respects, Decision and Order No. 19398 remains unchanged.


