ORDER

I.

By application filed on January 13, 2003, HALE MALIKO LLC ("Applicant") requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier by motor vehicle on the island of Maui in the 1-to-7 and 8-to-25 passenger classifications.

By notices of dismissal dated March 4, 2003, March 21, 2003 and June 4, 2003 (individually, "Notice to Dismiss") (collectively, "Notices to Dismiss"), we informed Applicant of our intent to dismiss the application without prejudice because of Applicant's failure to respond to the commission's request for information. Applicant was further advised that any objection to the dismissal of the application must be submitted in writing and filed not later than ten days from the date of the Notice to Dismiss, and that if an objection was not filed, the commission would issue an order dismissing the application.

Applicant failed to either sufficiently respond to the commission's request for information or object to the dismissal of the application within the ten-day period for any of the Notices to Dismiss.¹ We, thus, find that there is good cause to dismiss the application in this docket, without prejudice.

II.

On February 18, 2003, motions to intervene were filed by Katherine Barr, dba Town & Country Limousine, Temptation Tours, Inc., and Wailea Limousine Service, Inc. (collectively, "Motions to Intervene"). We find that dismissing the application without prejudice will render the Motions to Intervene moot. We, thus, conclude that the Motions to Intervene should be dismissed.

III.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

The application filed by Applicant on January 13,
2003, is dismissed without prejudice.

2. The Motion to Intervene by Katherine Barr, dba Town & Country Limousine, filed on February 18, 2003 is dismissed as moot.

3. The Motion to Intervene by Temptation Tours, Inc., filed on February 18, 2003, is dismissed as moot.

4. The Motion to Intervene by Wailea Limousine Service, Inc., filed on February 18, 2003, is dismissed as moot.

5. This docket is closed.

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¹Applicant responded in writing to the commission, on April 24, 2003, with assurances that it would complete its application. However, Applicant failed to submit the necessary information to complete the application (specifically, its tax clearance certificate). The commission sent a third Notice to Dismiss on June 4, 2003. Neither an objection nor a tax clearance certificate was received to this Notice to Dismiss.
