ORDER

I.

By Order No. 19370, filed on May 28, 2002, in this docket, certificate of public convenience and necessity no. 436-C ("Certificate No. 436-C"), held by GEORGE Y. MURASAKI ("Petitioner"), was placed on inactive status until May 28, 2003. By letter filed on June 27, 2003, Petitioner requests commission approval to voluntarily surrender his authority under Certificate No. 436-C. Under Certificate No. 436-C, Petitioner is authorized to transport passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 1-to-7 passenger classification.

In accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") § 271-19, operating authority under a certificate of public convenience and necessity may be terminated upon application of the holder. The commission finds good cause to grant Petitioner's request to terminate his authority.

II.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Petitioner's authority to transport passengers under Certificate No. 436-C is terminated, effective from the date of this order.


2. Petitioner shall surrender his certificate and remove any markings from the vehicles used in his operations. Petitioner shall comply with the foregoing requirements within 30 days from the date of this order.


3. If Petitioner fails to comply with the foregoing requirements within the time period specified, he may be subject to penalties pursuant to HRS § 271-27.

4. This docket is closed.




