ORDER

I.

On May 13, 2003, HAWAIIAN ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC. ("HECO") filed an application for approval to commit an estimated \$660,153 for Item P0000669, the conversion from overhead to underground within the Kakaako Redevelopment District, Improvement District No. 10 project. HECO makes its request under Rule 2.3.g.2 of General Order No. 7, Standards for Electric Utility Service in the State of Hawaii ("G.O. No. 7").¹

Copies of the application were served on the DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF CONSUMER ADVOCACY ("Consumer Advocate"). On June 3, 2003, the Consumer Advocate filed its preliminary statement of position indicating its participation in this docket and its intention to serve HECO with information requests ("IRs"). The Consumer

Advocate served HECO with IRs on June 17, 2003. On July 11, 2003, HECO filed its responses to the Consumer Advocate's IRs.

Rule 2.3.g.2 of G.O. No. 7 provides that if the commission does not act on an electric utility's application and render a decision and order within 90 days of its filing ("90-day Review Period"), the utility will be allowed "to include the project in its rate base without the determination by the [c]omission required by this rule." The 90-day Review Period for the commission to act on HECO's application in this docket expires on August 11, 2003.

On July 9, 2003, HECO filed a letter requesting an extension of the 90-day Review Period to August 22, 2003 ("Extension Request"). HECO makes its Extension Request to provide additional time for the Consumer Advocate to file its statement of position and for the commission to render its decision.

II.

Upon review, we find good cause to approve HECO's Extension Request. The expiration of the current 90-day Review Period is looming, and additional time for the Consumer Advocate to file its statement of position in this docket and for the commission to review the record and render its decision is reasonable at this time. In an effort to facilitate the smooth disposition of the application in this docket, the commission also finds it reasonable to require the Consumer Advocate to file

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its statement of position on the matters of this docket by August 8, 2003.

Accordingly, we conclude that: (1) HECO's Extension Request, filed on July 9, 2003, should be approved; and (2) the Consumer Advocate should file its statement of position in this docket by August 8, 2003.

III.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. HECO's Extension Request, filed on July 9, 2003, requesting the extension of the 90-day Review Period for the application in this docket until August 22, 2003, is approved.

2. The Consumer Advocate shall file its statement of position on the matters of this docket by August 8, 2003, unless otherwise ordered by the commission.
