

<u>ORDER</u>

I.

By Decision and Order No. 14834, filed on August 1, 1996, the commission granted AMERITECH COMMUNICATIONS INTERNATIONAL, INC. ("Petitioner") a certificate of authority ("COA") to operate as a reseller of intrastate telecommunications services. Petitioner was issued COA-0010 by the commission.

By letter dated July 14, 2003, filed on July 21, 2003, Petitioner seeks commission approval to voluntarily surrender its COA. Petitioner represents that:

- 1. On December 26, 2002, Petitioner was dissolved as a corporate entity.
- It "has not provided or no longer provides local or local distance service in the [S]tate of Hawaii."
- 3. "Consumers are not affected by canceling this service."

On August 11, 2003, Petitioner submitted its applicable public utility fees, in response to the commission's directive.

Upon review, the commission will: (1) approve the voluntary surrender of Petitioner's COA; and (2) waive the customer notification requirement set forth in Hawaii Administrative Rules § 6-80-123(a), as Petitioner represents that it has no intrastate customers to notify of its proposed discontinuance of telecommunications services.

II.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Petitioner's request to surrender COA-0010 to operate as a reseller of intrastate telecommunications services is approved, effective from the date of this order. Petitioner shall promptly return COA-0010 to the commission.

2. This docket is closed.
