ORDER

I.

By Order No. 19661, filed on September 19, 2002, in this docket, certificate of public convenience and necessity no. 1270-C ("Certificate No. 1270-C"), held by IN BAE KIM ("Petitioner"), was placed on inactive status until September 19, 2003. By letter filed on August 27, 2003, Petitioner requests commission approval to voluntarily surrender his authority under Certificate No. 1270-C. Under Certificate No. 1270-C, Petitioner is authorized to transport passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 8-to-25 passenger classification, limited to limousines.

In accordance with HRS § 271-19, operating authority under a certificate of public convenience and necessity may be terminated upon application of the holder. The commission finds good cause to grant Petitioner's request to terminate his authority.


II.


THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Petitioner's authority to transport passengers under Certificate No. 1270-C is terminated, effective from the date of this order.
2. Petitioner shall remove any markings from the vehicles used in his operations. Petitioner shall comply with the foregoing requirement within 10 days from the date of this order.
3. If Petitioner fails to comply with the foregoing requirement within the time period specified, he may be subject to penalties pursuant to HRS § 271-27.
4. This docket is closed.


