ORDER

I.

Introduction

HAWAIIAN ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC. ("HECO") requests commission approval to commit an estimated \$22,909,230 for Item Y00030, its new Dispatch Center, through an application filed on October 2, 2003. HECO makes its request under Rule 2.3.g.2 of General Order No. 7, *Standards for Electric Utility Service in the State of Hawaii*.¹

HECO served the DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF CONSUMER ADVOCACY ("Consumer Advocate") with copies of its application.

II.

Scheduling Requirements

The commission finds that establishing a procedural schedule at this juncture would aid in the efficient and timely

disposition of the instant proceeding. The commission concludes that HECO and the Consumer Advocate (collectively, the "Parties") should informally meet to formulate the issues, procedures, and schedule regarding this proceeding in a stipulated scheduling order. The stipulated scheduling order should be submitted for the commission's review and approval within 20 days from the date of this order. In the alternative, if unable to agree on a stipulated order, we conclude that each party should submit a proposed scheduling order for the commission's consideration within 20 days of the date of this order.

Orders


THE COMMISSION ORDERS the Parties to informally meet to formulate a stipulated scheduling order that sets forth the issues, procedures, and schedule of this proceeding. The stipulated scheduling order shall be submitted within 20 days of the date of this order for the commission's review and approval. In the alternative, if unable to agree on a stipulated order, each party shall submit its own proposed scheduling order for the commission's consideration within 20 days from the date of this order.
