ORDER

I.

Request to Surrender Common Carrier Authority

R & L TRUCK RENTAL ("Petitioner") filed a letter on April 16, 2003, requesting commission approval to voluntarily surrender its authority under certificate of public convenience and necessity number 2001-C ("Certificate No. 2001-C"). Certificate No. 2001-C authorizes Petitioner to transport property by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the dump truck classification. As part of its request, Petitioner returned Certificate No. 2001-C to the commission.

In accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") § 271-19, operating authority under a certificate of public convenience and necessity may be terminated upon application of the holder. The commission finds good cause to grant Petitioner's request to terminate its authority.¹

¹We note, however, that by letters dated April 17, 2003, and September 15, 2003, the commission requested that Petitioner file its annual financial report ("AFR") for 2003, and pay the accompanying fee. Petitioner did not respond to either request.

II.

Orders

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Petitioner's authority to transport property under Certificate No. 2001-C is terminated, effective from the date of this order.

2. Petitioner shall file its 2003 AFR and pay the required fee, pursuant to HRS §§ 271-25 and 271-36. Petitioner shall remove any markings from the vehicles used in its operations. Petitioner shall comply with the foregoing requirements within 15 days from the date of this order.


3. If Petitioner fails to comply with the foregoing requirements within the time period specified, it may be subject to penalties pursuant to HRS § 271-27.

4. This docket is closed.




