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DECISION AND ORDER

The commission ordered EDWARD MARIA, dba E. MARIA TRUCKING ("Respondent") to appear at 465 South King Street, Room B3, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, at 9:00 a.m., on November 26, 2003 to show cause why Respondent's certificate of public convenience and necessity number 2031-C should not be suspended or revoked for failure to file an annual financial report ("AFR"), pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") § 271-25 and Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") § 6-62-42(a), and to pay an annual motor carrier gross revenue fee ("Fee"), pursuant to HRS § 271-36 and HAR § 6-62-24(a).


On October 31, 2003, Respondent filed its 2002 AFR and paid \$801.96, representing its Fee and penalties and interest assessed pursuant to HRS § 271-27(i) and HAR §§ 6-62-24(b), 6-62-24(c), and 6-62-42(d).


The commission finds that Respondent has fully complied, although belatedly, with the motor carrier laws, rules, and regulations, and concludes that Order No. 20489, filed on October 27, 2003, should be vacated.


THE COMMISSION ORDERS that Order No. 20489 is vacated and this docket is closed.
