ORDER

The commission ordered KEALIA WATER COMPANY HOLDINGS, LLC ("KWCH") and the DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF CONSUMER ADVOCACY ("Consumer Advocate") to informally meet to formulate a stipulated scheduling order or, if unable to stipulate, respective proposed scheduling orders by Order No. 20595, filed on October 28, 2003 ("Order" or "Order No. 20595"). The commission required KWCH and the Consumer Advocate to make their filing within thirty (30) days of the date of the Order for the commission's review and approval, which is on or about November 27, 2003.

Notice of KWCH's application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity ("CPCN") authorizing KWCH to provide water on the Island of Kauai, District of Kealia, and approval of its proposed rates, rules, and regulations was published statewide on November 13, 2003, pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") § 6-61-57(2). HAR § 6-61-57(2) requires a motion to intervene or participate in a proceeding


regarding an application for the issuance or transfer of a CPCN to be filed not later than twenty (20) days after the notice of the pending application is published. The intervention/participation period for the matters in this docket ends on or about December 3, 2003. The commission finds good cause to suspend the filing requirements of Order No. 20595 until further order of the commission due to the provisions of HAR § 6-61-57(2).


THE COMMISSION ORDERS that the filing requirements of Order No. 20595 are suspended until further order of the commission.




