DECISION AND ORDER

The commission ordered 4U TOURS, LTD., dba TABI TRANSPORTATION ("Respondent") to appear at 465 South King Street, Room B3, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, at 9:00 a.m., on November 26, 2003 to show cause why Respondent's certificate of public convenience and necessity number 1232-C should not be suspended or revoked for failure to file an annual financial report ("AFR"), pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") § 271-25 and Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") § 6-62-42(a), and to pay an annual motor carrier gross revenue fee ("Fee"), pursuant to HRS § 271-36 and HAR § 6-62-24(a), for the year 2002.

On November 12, 2003, Respondent filed its 2002 AFR and paid its Fee and \$1,258.02 of penalties and interest that the commission assessed, pursuant to HRS § 271-27(i) and HAR §§ 6-62-24(b), 6-62-24(c), and 6-62-42(d).




THE COMMISSION ORDERS that Order No. 20500 is vacated and this docket is closed.


