<u>ORDER</u>

I.

Motion to Intervene

On September 26, 2003, MARINE CLUB COMPANY, LLC ("Applicant") filed an application with the commission for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Hawaii, excluding Waipio Valley, in the 8-to-25 passenger classification.

On September 29, 2003, the Division of Consumer Advocacy, Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, filed its statement of position with the commission informing the commission that it will not participate in the instant docket.

On November 26, 2003, a motion to intervene in the instant docket ("Motion to Intervene") was filed by Jack's Tours, Inc. ("Jack's Tours").

Discussion

Pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") § 6-61-57(2), the deadline for intervention is not later than 20 days after a notice of pending application has been published in a newspaper of general circulation within the State of Hawaii, or within the county or counties affected by the application.

Notice of Applicant's pending application was published in the Hilo Tribune Herald on November 4, 2003. Pursuant to HAR § 6-61-57(2), the last day for intervention was November 24, 2003.¹ Notwithstanding that Jack's Tours may have relied on the incorrect date of November 25, 2003 as the last day for filing any motions to intervene, its filing of its Motion to Intervene with the commission on November 26, 2003 was still untimely. We, thus, find that Jack's Tours' Motion to Intervene is untimely, and accordingly conclude that its Motion to Intervene should be denied.

III.

<u>Order</u>

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that Jack's Tours' Motion to Intervene, filed on November 26, 2003, is denied.

II.

¹The Notice to Interested Persons published in the Hawaii Tribune Herald inadvertently referenced the 20th day after publication, and thus, the deadline for motions to intervene, as being November 25, 2003. The date should have read November 24, 2003. Nonetheless, Jack's Tours' Motion to Intervene was not filed with the commission until November 26, 2003.
