Thus, the commission concludes that Applicant and the Consumer Advocate should meet to formulate the issues, procedures and schedule with respect to this proceeding, to be set forth in a stipulated scheduling order that shall be submitted for commission approval 20 days from the date of this order. In the alternative, if the parties are unable to stipulate to such order, we conclude that each party shall submit a proposed scheduling order for the commission's consideration 20 days from the date of this order.

If unable to stipulate to such an order, each party shall submit its own proposed scheduling order


for the commission's consideration within 20 days from the date of this order.
