ORDER

I.

Introduction

On May 30, 2003, WAIKIKI BEACH CONDOMINIUMS ("WBC") filed an application ("Application") requesting commission approval to operate as a provider of shared tenant services for the tenants and occupants of a residential apartment building at 444 Nahua Street in Honolulu, Hawaii. WBC served copies of the Application on the DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF CONSUMER ADVOCACY ("Consumer Advocate").

On August 26, 2003, the Consumer Advocate issued information requests upon WBC, to which WBC did not respond. On November 1, 2004, the commission issued a Notice of Intent to Dismiss Application ("Notice") to WBC, stating that the commission would dismiss WBC's Application without prejudice for failure to move forward with the completion of the Application.¹ On November 3, 2004, WBC wrote to withdraw its Application,

¹The Notice, among other things, also advised WBC that it must object to the dismissal of its Application in writing not later than ten (10) days from the date of the Notice.

stating the company is "not planning to resume this process at any future date."

Upon review of the record, the commission will:
(1) approve the WBC's request to withdraw the Application; and
(2) close the instant docket.


THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


1. WBC's November 3, 2004 request to withdraw its Application, filed on May 30, 2003, is approved.
