ORDER

I.

Introduction

an application filed on December 16, By MAUI ELECTRIC COMPANY, LIMITED ("MECO"), requests that commission: (1)approve the Power Purchase Contract For As-Available Energy (the "PPC"), dated December 3, 2004, by and between MECO and Kaheawa Wind Power, LLC ("KWP"); (2) authorize MECO to include the purchase energy charges (and related revenue taxes) that MECO incurs under the PPC in MECO's Energy Cost Adjustment Clause for the term of the PPC; (3) find that the purchased power arrangements under the PPC are prudent and in the public and (4)determine that interest; the MECO-owned Interconnection Facilities (two 69 kilovolt line drops) constructed above the surface of the ground, pursuant Hawaii Revised Statutes § 269-27.6(a).

Applicant served copies of the application on the DIVISION OF CONSUMER ADVOCACY, DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS ("Consumer Advocate"), an ex officio party to this docket, pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes § 269-51.

II.

Discussion

The commission believes that the establishment of a procedural schedule at this juncture will aid in the efficient and timely disposition of this matter. Thus, we conclude that MECO and the Consumer Advocate should meet informally to formulate the issues, procedures, and schedule with respect to this proceeding, to be set forth in a stipulated prehearing order that shall be submitted for commission approval within 30 days from the date of this order. In the alternative, if the parties are unable to stipulate to such order, we conclude that each party shall submit a proposed prehearing order for the commission's consideration within 30 days from the date of this order.

III.

Orders

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that MECO and the Consumer Advocate shall meet informally to formulate the issues, procedures, and schedule with respect to this proceeding, to be set forth in a stipulated prehearing order. The stipulated prehearing order shall be submitted for commission approval within 30 days of this order. If MECO and the Consumer Advocate are unable to

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stipulate to such an order, each party shall submit a proposed prehearing order for the commission's consideration by the same date.
