ORDER

By this order, the commission suspends all filings in this docket, until further order by the commission.

I.

Introduction

On April 23, 2004, the commission issued Prehearing Order No. 20923, setting forth the regulatory schedule and procedures that govern this proceeding.¹

On December 16, 2004², the commission issued a letter, informing the Parties and Participants that it intends to implement a hearing format that is substantially similar to the hearing format recently implemented at the hearings held

on December 8-10, 2004 in Docket No. 03-0371 relating to Distributed Generation.³ By that same letter, the commission also gave the Parties and Participants an opportunity to submit proposals, jointly or independently, to amend Prehearing Order No. 20923 for the commission's review and approval.

On January 5, 2005, The DIVISION OF CONSUMER ADVOCACY, DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS, KAUAI ISLAND UTILITY COOPERATIVE, HAWAIIAN ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC., HAWAII ELECTRIC LIGHT COMPANY, INC., MAUI ELECTRIC COMPANY, LIMITED, THE GAS COMPANY, HESS MICROGEN, the COUNTY OF MAUI, HAWAII RENEWABLE ENERGY ALLIANCE, and the COUNTY OF KAUAI (collectively referred to as "Stipulating Parties and Participants")⁴ submitted a letter, proposing modifications to the regulatory schedule and requesting that the Commission submit its discovery requests at the same time discovery is conducted by the Parties and Participants.

The commission is currently reviewing the filing of the Stipulating Parties and Participants and will be issuing an Amended Schedule. Accordingly, the commission will suspend any and all filings within this docket, until further order by the commission.


