ORDER

By this order, the commission places certificate of public convenience and necessity no. 1701-C ("Certificate No. 1701-C"), held by EASY TRANSPORTATION COMPANY, INC., dba EASY TRANSPORT COMPANY ("Petitioner"), on inactive status for an additional one-year period, until January 23, 2006.

I.

Request to Extend Inactive Status

On January 21, 2005, Petitioner filed a letter requesting that the inactive status of its Certificate No. 1701-C be extended for an additional year. By Order No. 20777, filed on January 23, 2004, in this docket, Certificate No. 1701-C was placed on inactive status until January 23, 2005.

The commission notes that pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes § 271-19, the commission may grant inactive status for a cumulative period not to exceed two years over the life of the certificate. We find that there is good cause to grant Petitioner's request for an extension of its inactive status for an additional year. We conclude that Petitioner's request should be granted.

II.

<u>Orders</u>

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Petitioner's Certificate No. 1701-C is placed on inactive status for an additional one-year period, until January 23, 2006.

2. If Certificate No. 1701-C is not reactivated prior to the expiration of the period of inactivity, it shall be declared abandoned and revoked. The request to reactivate Certificate No. 1701-C, along with the filing of all required documents necessary for reactivation must be completed prior to the expiration of the inactivity period, or Certificate No. 1701-C shall be revoked.

3. Petitioner shall not transfer its inactive certificate unless Petitioner can first establish good cause to the commission for the transfer, and the commission has approved the request to transfer.
