By this Order, the commission requires the parties to meet informally and formulate the issues, procedures and schedule with respect to this proceeding, to be set forth in a stipulated procedural order that shall be submitted for commission approval within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.

I.

Background

On March 24, 2005, the commission issued Order No. 21707, in Docket No. 05-0075, opening a proceeding to investigate the proposed revised integrated resource plan ("IRP") and demand side management ("DSM") framework proposed by KAUAI ISLAND UTILITY COOPERATIVE ("KIUC"). The commission made KIUC and the DIVISION OF CONSUMER ADVOCACY, DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS ("Consumer Advocate") parties to this docket. Pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") Chapter 6-61, the commission invited interested persons or

entities to file motions to intervene or participate without intervention, within twenty (20) days of Order No. 21707.

No parties have moved to intervene or participate in this proceeding, pursuant to HAR §§ 6-61-55, 6-61-56 and 6-61-57 and in accordance with Order No. 21707. Therefore, we conclude that KIUC and the Consumer Advocate should meet informally to formulate the issues, procedures and schedule with respect to this proceeding, to be set forth in a stipulated procedural order that shall be submitted for commission approval within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order. In the alternative, if the parties are unable to stipulate to such order, each party shall submit a proposed procedural order for the commission's consideration within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.

II.

Orders

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that KIUC and the Consumer Advocate shall meet informally to formulate the issues, procedures, and schedule with respect to this proceeding, to be set forth in a stipulated procedural order. The stipulated procedural order shall be submitted for commission approval within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order. If unable to stipulate to such an order, each party shall submit its own proposed procedural order for the commission's consideration within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.
