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ORDER

By this Order, the commission places certificate of public convenience and necessity no. 1579-C ("Certificate No. 1579-C"), held by YAREE ALIPOUR ("Petitioner"), on inactive status for one (1) year, effective from the date of this Order.

I.

Request to Place Common Carrier Authority on Inactive Status

On January 21, 2004, Petitioner filed a letter requesting that Certificate No. 1579-C¹ be placed on inactive status. By letters dated January 23, 2004 and April 12, 2004, the commission requested that Petitioner file an annual financial report for the period January 1, 2004 through to the date of his request for inactive status, January 21, 2004. On March 29, 2005, Petitioner filed the requested annual financial report.

^{&#}x27;Certificate No. 1579-C authorizes Petitioner to transport passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 1-to-7 passenger classification.

Under Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") § 271-19, the commission may place a certificate on inactive status upon written request by a motor carrier, and for good cause shown. The inactive period, however, may not exceed twelve (12) months. In addition, HRS § 271-19 provides that inactive status may only be granted for a cumulative period not to exceed two (2) years over the life of the certificate.

The commission finds that there is good cause to grant Petitioner's request. If Petitioner so desires he may file, prior to the expiration of the inactive period granted by this Order, a request to extend his inactive status for up to one (1) additional year.

II.

<u>Orders</u>

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 1. Petitioner's Certificate No. 1579-C is placed on inactive status for one (1) year, effective from the date of this Order.
- 2. If Certificate No. 1579-C is not reactivated prior to the expiration of the period of inactivity, it shall be declared abandoned and revoked. The request to reactivate Certificate No. 1579-C, along with the filing of all documents necessary for reactivation must be completed prior to the expiration of the inactivity period, or Certificate No. 1579-C shall be revoked.

3. Petitioner shall not transfer his inactive certificate unless Petitioner can first establish good cause to the commission for the transfer, and the commission has approved the request to transfer.
