#### Introduction

October 28, 2004, HECO On filed an Application requesting the commission to: (1) approve its Combined Heat and Power ("CHP") Agreement with Pacific Allied Products, Limited ("Pacific Allied"), dated September 8, 2004; (2) approve the inclusion of the CHP system fuel costs, ground transportation and related taxes in HECO's Energy Cost Adjustment Clause ("ECAC") to the extent that the costs are not recovered in HECO's base rates; approve modification of HECO's ECAC to facilitate the (3) recovery of the incurred Pacific Allied CHP system fuel costs, ground transportation and related taxes; (4)approve modification to HECO's quarterly filed avoided energy cost rates

related to the modification of HECO's ECAC; and (5) grant HECO such other relief and further relief as may be just and equitable in the premises.<sup>1</sup>

On January 21, 2005, the commission issued Order No. 21555, suspending this proceeding pending the disposition of Docket No. 03-0371.

On March 4, 2005, HECO filed a notice to withdraw its Application.

THE COMMISSION APPROVES HECO's withdrawal of its Application. This docket is closed unless otherwise ordered by the commission.
