ORDER

The commission closes this docket following the recent filing of the final report by YOUNG BROTHERS, LIMITED ("Young Brothers").

On December 20, 2002, the commission approved Young Brothers' requests to: (1) dispose of its back-up PT&S 286-1 barge ("PT&S barge"); and (2) to engage in certain accounting treatment associated with the disposal and sale of the PT&S barge.¹ Young Brothers also informed the commission of its intent to lease a used barge, known as the Pacific Barge, as a temporary replacement, until a new barge is placed into service. The commission, as part of its approval, ordered Young Brothers to file certain reports, including a report detailing the costs incurred for the rental of the Pacific Barge, following the termination of the lease (the "Final Cost Report").²



THE COMMISSION ORDERS that, unless ordered otherwise, this docket is closed.




