Unfortunately, the procedural schedules set forth in the numerous pending docketed matters currently before the Commission, in particular the efforts of three of the Parties to the instant docket on the pending HECO rate application (which is the subject of Docket No. 04-0113) has prevented the Parties to the instant [docket] from having an opportunity to devote the necessary resources to Docket No. 7310 at this time.<sup>3</sup>

The commission approves the Parties' request for an extension of time, until November 30, 2005, to comply with Order No. 21121.<sup>4</sup>

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that the Parties' request for an extension of time, until November 30, 2005, to review and update, if necessary, the agreements, information, and data contained in their Stipulation, is approved.


