ORDER

By this Order, the commission dismisses as untimely POLYNESIAN ADVENTURE TOURS, INC.'s ("Applicant") motion for reconsideration of Order No. 22049 ("Motion for Reconsideration"), filed on October 6, 2005, in the matter of Applicant's application for temporary motor carrier authority ("Application").

I.

Background

22049, filed on September 23, 2005, By Order No. ("Order No. 22049") the commission denied Applicant's Application, filed on August 16, 2005, for temporary motor carrier authority. On October 6, 2005, Applicant filed a Motion for Reconsideration of Order No. 22049, pursuant to HAR §§ 6-61-137, 6-61-21 and 6-61-22.

II.

Discussion

To be considered timely, a motion for reconsideration must be filed within ten (10) days after a decision or order in

question is served upon a party. HAR § 6-61-137. In addition, HAR § 6-61-21(d) provides:

"Service upon a party, other than the commission, shall be deemed complete upon the occurrence of at least one of the following:

- (1) The party or its attorney is personally served;
- (2) The document is delivered to the party's office or its attorney's office and left with some responsible person; or
- (3) The document is **properly stamped**, addressed, and mailed to the last known address of the party on file with the commission or to its attorney."

(Emphasis added.)

Order No. 22049 was served upon Applicant September 23, 2005, by mail as provided for in HAR § 6-61-21(d)(3), it was filed, and stamped, addressed, and mailed as Applicant's last known address September 23, 2005. on Consequently, in accordance with HAR § 6-61-21(d)(3), service was completed on September 23, 2005, and pursuant to HAR §§ 6-61-137, 6-61-22 and 6-61-21(e), Applicant had until October 5, 2005 to file its Motion for Reconsideration, which is ten (10) days, plus two (2) days, from September 23, 2005.1

In its Motion for Reconsideration, Applicant erroneously states that Order No. 22049 "was served on Applicant, via first-class mail postage pre-paid, and received in the mail on

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¹HAR § 6-61-137 provides, in relevant part, that a motion for reconsideration shall be filed "within ten days after the decision or order is served upon the party". HAR § 6-61-22 provides, in relevant part, that Saturdays, Sundays and holidays are included in the computation of time when the prescribed time is more than seven (7) days, and HAR § 6-61-21(e) provides, in relevant part, that two (2) days shall be added to a prescribed period of time when a party is served by mail.

Monday, September 26, 2005". As noted above, Order No. 22049 was served upon Applicant on September 23, 2005.

Based upon the discussion above, to be timely, Applicant's Motion for Reconsideration should have been filed with the commission by October 5, 2005. Applicant's Motion for Reconsideration was filed with the commission on October 6, 2005. We, thus, find that Applicant's Motion for Reconsideration was untimely, and conclude that the Motion for Reconsideration should be dismissed.

III.

Order

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that Applicant's Motion for Reconsideration of Order No. 22049 is dismissed as untimely.
