<u>ORDER</u>

By this Order, the commission orders that certificate of public convenience and necessity no. 1621-C ("Certificate No. 1621-C"), held by SUPER HAWAII GROUP, LLC ("Petitioner"), is terminated, effective from the date of this Order.

I.

Request to Surrender Common Carrier Authority

On May 31, 2005, Petitioner filed a letter requesting commission approval to voluntarily surrender its authority under 1621-C. Certificate No. Under Certificate No. 1621-C, Petitioner is authorized to transport passengers bv motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 8-to-25 passenger classification, limited to utilizing motor vehicles with a maximum manufacturer's seating capacity of 15 passengers, and further limited to providing transportation services over irregular routes between Waikiki, Hawaii Kai, and Makapuu Point.

II.

Findings and Conclusions

In accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") § 271-19, operating authority under a certificate of public convenience and necessity may be terminated upon application of the holder. The commission finds good cause to grant Petitioner's request to terminate its authority.

III.

Orders

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Petitioner's authority to transport passengers under Certificate No. 1621-C is terminated, effective from the date of this Order.

2. Petitioner shall surrender its certificate and remove any markings from the vehicles used in its operations. Petitioner shall comply with the foregoing requirement within fifteen (15) days from the date of this Order.

3. If Petitioner fails to comply with the foregoing requirement within the time period specified, it may be subject to penalties pursuant to HRS § 271-27.

4. This docket is closed unless otherwise ordered by the commission.
