<u>ORDER</u>

By this Order, the commission orders that Permit No. 646-P, held by J.D. TRUCKING ("Petitioner"), is terminated, effective from the date of this Order.

I.

Request to Surrender Contract Carrier Authority

On October 21, 2005, Petitioner filed a letter requesting commission approval to voluntarily surrender its authority under Permit No. 646-P. Under Permit No. 646-P, Petitioner is authorized to transport hollow concrete masonry units and related products, including cement in bags, lime in bags, reinforcing wire, and wooden pallets, on the island of Oahu pursuant to its contract with Tileco, Inc.

II.

Findings and Conclusions

In accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") § 271-19, operating authority under a permit may be terminated

upon application of the holder. The commission finds good cause to grant Petitioner's request to terminate its authority.

III.

<u>Orders</u>

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 1. Petitioner's authority to transport property under Permit No. 646-P is terminated, effective from the date of this Order.
- 2. Petitioner shall remove any markings from the vehicles used in its operations. Petitioner shall comply with the foregoing requirement within fifteen (15) days from the date of this Order.
- 3. If Petitioner fails to comply with the foregoing requirement within the time period specified, it may be subject to penalties pursuant to HRS § 271-27.
- 4. This docket is closed unless otherwise ordered by the commission.
