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ORDER

By this Order, the commission places certificate of public convenience and necessity no. 5721-C ("Certificate No. 5721-C"), held by VON HAILI MELNICK, dba MELNICK'S MOTOR SERVICE ("Petitioner"), on inactive status for an additional twelve (12)-month period, from December 23, 2005 to December 22, 2006.

I.

Request to Extend Inactive Status

On November 21, 2005, Petitioner filed a letter requesting that the inactive status of his Certificate No. 5721-C be extended for an additional year. By Order No. 21519, filed on December 23, 2004, in this docket, Certificate No. 5721-C was placed on inactive status until December 22, 2005.

The commission notes that pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes § 271-19(b), the commission may grant inactive status for a cumulative period not to exceed two (2) years over the life of the certificate. We find that there is good cause to grant

Petitioner's request for an extension of his inactive status for an additional year. We conclude that Petitioner's request should be granted.

II.

Orders

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 1. Petitioner's Certificate No. 5721-C is placed on inactive status for an additional twelve (12)-month period, from December 23, 2005 to December 22, 2006.
- 2. Pursuant to HRS § 271-19(b), if Certificate No. 5721-C is not reactivated prior to the expiration of the period of inactivity, it shall be declared abandoned and revoked. The request to reactivate Certificate No. 5721-C, along with the filing of all documents necessary for reactivation must be completed prior to the expiration of the inactivity period, or Certificate No. 5721-C shall be revoked.
- 3. Petitioner shall not transfer his inactive certificate unless Petitioner can first establish good cause to the commission for the transfer, and the commission has approved the request to transfer.
