ORDER

By this Order, the commission vacates Decision and Order No. 22017, filed on September 8, 2005.

I.

Application for Common Carrier Authority

By Decision and Order No. 22017, filed on September 8, 2005, the commission approved the application of JONG WON PARK, dba HANS GOLF TOUR ("Applicant"), for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 1-to-7 passenger classification. The commission also ordered Applicant, as a condition of approval of the application, to comply with all commission requirements for common carriers, including submitting certain documents within one hundred and twenty (120) days of the issuance of the Decision and Order. The commission also notified Applicant that failure to timely comply with the commission's requirements would

constitute cause for the commission to void the Decision and Order.

Applicant was served with a copy of the Decision and Order by mail, postage prepaid, on the same day that the Decision and Order was issued, in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules §§ 6-61-21 and 6-61-122. Additionally, the commission sent a letter to Applicant, dated September 8, 2005, which reiterated the commission's requirements and specified January 8, 2006, as the deadline for compliance.

## II.

### Findings and Conclusions

Applicant has not complied with the requirements set forth in Decision and Order No. 22017 within the one hundred and twenty (120)-day time period set forth in the Decision and Order. The commission, thus, determines that Decision and Order No. 22017 should be vacated.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


1. Decision and Order No. 22017, filed on September 8, 2005, is vacated.


