ORDER

By this Order, the commission orders that Decision and Order No. 22796 is vacated and this docket is closed.

I.

Application for Common Carrier Authority

On August 24, 2006, in Decision and Order No. 22796, the commission approved the application of HAWAIIAN ROLL OFF SERVICES LLC, dba SOUTH KONA HAULING COMPANY ("Applicant"), for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier of property by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Hawaii in the general commodities and dump truck classifications, limited to serving the areas of North and South Kona. We also: (1) ordered Applicant, as a condition to our approval of the application, to comply with all commission requirements for common carriers, including submitting certain documents within one hundred and twenty (120) days of the issuance of the decision and order; and (2) notified Applicant that failure to timely comply with the commission's requirements would constitute cause for the commission to vacate the Decision and Order. We served Applicant with a copy of the Decision and Order by mail, postage prepaid, on the same day that Decision and Order was issued, in accordance with the Administrative Rules §§ 6-61-21 6-61-122. Hawaii and Additionally, we sent a letter to Applicant, dated August 24, 2006, which reiterated the commission's requirements and specified December 24, 2006, as the deadline for compliance.

II.

Findings and Conclusions

The one hundred and twenty (120)-day time period has passed, and Applicant has not complied with the requirements set forth in Decision and Order No. 22796. The commission, thus, determines that Decision and Order No. 22796 should be vacated.

III.

Orders

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

Decision and Order No. 22796 is vacated and this docket is closed unless otherwise ordered by the commission.
