By this Order, the commission orders that Decision and Order No. 23083 is vacated and this docket is closed.

## Application for Common Carrier Authority

On November 27, 2006, in Decision and Order No. 23083, the commission approved the application of RICK KAMAKAOKALANI MIKAELE, dba PRINCIPLE LIMOUSINE ("Applicant"), to extend his certificate of public authority under convenience and 5746-C to include the 8-to-25 passenger necessity number classification on the island of Hawaii, excluding Waipio Valley. (1) ordered Applicant, as a condition to our approval We also: of the application, to comply with all commission requirements for common carriers, including submitting certain documents within one hundred and twenty (120) days of the issuance of the decision and order; and (2) notified Applicant that failure to timely comply with the commission's requirements would constitute cause for the commission to vacate the Decision and Order.

We served Applicant with a copy of the Decision and Order by mail, postage prepaid, on the same day that the Decision and Order was issued, in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules §§ 6-61-21 and 6-61-122. Additionally, we sent a letter to Applicant, dated November 27, 2006, which reiterated the commission's requirements and specified March 27, 2007, as the deadline for compliance.

## Findings and Conclusions

The one hundred and twenty (120)-day time period has passed, and Applicant has not complied with the requirements set forth in Decision and Order No. 23083. The commission, thus, determines that Decision and Order No. 23083 should be vacated.

Decision and Order No. 23083 is vacated and this docket is closed unless otherwise ordered by the commission.
